Føstivø Couscous Salad

INGREDIENTS

- 1 cup uncooked couscous
- 1 ¼ cups chicken broth
- 3 tablespoons extra virgin olive oil
- 2 tablespoons fresh lime juice
- 1 teaspoon vinegar
- ½ teaspoon ground cumin
- 1 cup finely chopped fresh kale or spinach
- 1 red bell pepper, chopped
- Seeds from 1 pomegranate
- 1 cup frozen corn kernels, thawed
- ½ chopped English cucumber
- 1 can black beans, drained

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Bring chicken broth to boil in 2-quart or larger saucepan.
- 2. Stir in couscous. Cover pot and remove from heat.
- 3. Let stand 5 minutes. Stir in kale in warm couscous.
- 4. In large bowl, whisk together olive oil, lime juice and vinegar.
- Add cucumber, pepper, pomegranate, corn and beans. Toss to coat.
- 6. Add couscous to bowl with vegetables and mix well.
- 7. Season with salt and pepper to taste.
- 8. Serve at once or refrigerate until ready to eat.
